



## **Moneygall Football Club – Filming & Livestreaming Policy**

### **Purpose**

Moneygall Football Club (“the Club”) uses video and livestreaming technology (including VEO cameras) to support player development, coaching, and club promotion.

The Club is committed to protecting the privacy, dignity, and safety of all players, coaches, officials, and spectators in line with:

- The FAI Child Welfare & Safeguarding Policy
- The Data Protection Acts 1988–2018
- The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Guidance from the Data Protection Commission (DPC)

### **1. Lawful Basis & Scope**

Video recordings may include personal data (identifiable images). The Club’s lawful bases for processing are:

- Legitimate Interest – for coaching, match analysis, and club administration.
- Consent – required for publishing or livestreaming footage online or publicly.

This policy applies to all activity at the Club’s grounds in Moneygall and any external venues where the Club records matches.

### **2. Notice & Transparency**

- Signage will be displayed at all entrances and near the pitch when filming/streaming occurs.
- Players, parents/guardians, coaches, and visiting clubs will be informed at the start of each season.
- The Club’s Privacy Notice and this policy are available upon request or via the Club Secretary.

### **3. Purpose of Recordings**

Recordings may be used for:

- Coaching and player performance analysis
- Referee and coach development
- Club promotion (with prior consent)

Recordings will not be used for surveillance, disciplinary action, or commercial resale unless authorised by the Club Committee and compliant with FAI guidance.

#### 4. Livestreaming Rules

- Livestreaming is permitted only if:
  - The fixture is not subject to FAI or League broadcast restrictions.
  - All relevant consents (teams, parents/guardians) are obtained.
  - The stream is configured as Private or Unlisted unless otherwise approved by the Committee.
- Youth fixtures (North Tipperary Schoolchildren's League) will never be publicly streamed without explicit parental consent.

#### 5. Safeguarding & Children

When recording underage players:

- Only Garda-vetted and FAI Safeguarding 1-certified personnel may handle filming or livestreaming.
- No player will be identified by name in online publications.
- Filming is prohibited in changing rooms, showers, or any private area.
- Any safeguarding concern must be reported immediately to the Club Child Welfare Officer.

#### 6. Access, Storage & Retention

- Footage is securely stored in the Club's official VEO account and is password-protected.
- Access is restricted to authorised coaches and committee members only.
- Retention periods:
  - Coaching/analysis: up to 12 months.
  - Promotional use: retained only as long as necessary.
- Individuals may request access or deletion of footage that identifies them by contacting the Club's Data Protection Lead.

#### 7. Data Subject Rights

Anyone recorded may:

- Request a copy of relevant footage.
- Request correction or deletion where appropriate.
- Lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Commission ([www.dataprotection.ie](http://www.dataprotection.ie)) if unsatisfied with the Club's response.

#### 8. Breaches & Reporting

Any suspected data breach or safeguarding breach will be reported immediately to:

- The FAI Safeguarding Office ([safeguarding@fai.ie](mailto:safeguarding@fai.ie))
- The Data Protection Commission, if applicable.
